Instructions for Application for Membership 2013 – 2014

Welcome to the Oklahoma City Figure Skating Club (OKCFSC)! When you join the OKCFSC as a Full Member, you are also joining US Figure Skating (USFS), the National Governing Body for the sport of figure skating in the United States and one of the premier organizations of the Olympic movement in this country. The USFS provides the sanctioning required for skaters to test, compete, and participate in exhibitions while maintaining the eligible status required to compete at the Regional, Sectional, National, World and Olympic levels.

- * All Members under the age of 18 must also have a parent/guardian as member.
- * All Full Members age of 18 or over have voting privileges and may serve on the Board.
- * All Full Members receive membership in US Figure Skating
- * All principal Full Members receive a subscription to USFS's Skating magazine.
- * All memberships run from July 1st through June 30th and are renewed annually.

For skaters attending the 2014 Southwestern Regional Championship in October 2013 -- membership forms and payment must be received by the membership chairperson prior to September 1, 2013!

By paying dues, you agree to join the Oklahoma City Figure Skating Club and agree to abide by the by-laws and rules of the OKCFSC under the auspices of USFS.

VOLUNTEER HOURS

A lot of time and effort goes into coordinating and carrying out the events that make our club so great. In order to maintain this level of service to our members, we need volunteers at different times during the year. This membership year (July 1, 2013 – June 30, 2014), each family will be required to log ten hours of volunteer time for the club.

Opportunities to volunteer could include:

- Serving on the Board
- Bringing food for the hospitality room for judges and coaches
- Multiple opportunities helping out at ice shows, exhibitions, test sessions, and competitions
- Mentoring new members/skaters
- Coordinating fund raisers

At the end of the year, any family that has not reached the mandatory 10 hours of volunteer time will be assessed an additional fee of \$10/hour. Until this fee is paid, the members will not be in good standing with OKCFSC. Any family may opt out of volunteering at the beginning of the year by paying an additional \$100 with their membership renewal.
